c.	At the public hearing, make findings and order the repair be made if:		
	(1)	the drainage authority determines from the repair report and the evidence presented that the repairs recommended are necessary for the best interests of the affected property owners (M.S. 103E.715, Subd. 4(a)(1)); or	
	(2)	the repair petition is signed by the owners of at least 26 percent of the property area affected by and assessed for the original construction of the drainage system, and the	

drainage authority determines that the drainage system is in need of repair so that it no longer serves its original purpose and the cost of the repair will not exceed the total benefits determined in the original drainage system proceedings.
