Description	<p>Stormy SWCD requests the option of using the entire FY22 State Cost Share grant for technical and administrative expenses. This will allow the SWCD to provide additional technical assistance to landowners to facilitate implementation of State Cost Share or EQIP eligible conservation practices that will leverage Federal EQIP and/or watershed district funds for project installation. The additional funding for technical assistance will allow the SWCD to complete more project surveys and designs, which will accelerate landowner enrollment in Federal EQIP and watershed district programs. Stormy SWCD's most recent Financial Report indicated a 9-month fund balance.
