- RIM Reserve Conservation Easements
- To be eligible, majority of land MUST be in one of the following:
 - 1. Highly Vulnerable Drinking Water Supply Management Area
 - 2. Mitigation Level 1 or Level 2 Drinking Water Supply Management Area
 - 3. Where drinking water protection plans developed by Tribal governments have identified high vulnerability
- Priority is **cropland in row crop production**

Allowed Easement Activities

- 1. Habitat restoration
- 2. Habitat protection
- 3. **NEW!** Managed grazing
- NEW! Perennial crops: A crop rotation including at least three consecutive years of a perennial crop

Timeline

- Perpetual
- NEW! 25 years
